We started out as a few racers who just wanted to run their race cars to check tuning and get ready for Speed Week. Where else can you do this effectively except 'the great white dyno'. The first test and tune meets were a one mile approach to a 132' trap. The clocks had a digital time readout that had to be converted by hand to miles per hour. Someone finally put a conversion sheet together which helped. At least until Al Teague went over 299 m.p.h. and everyone had to wait for the calculations. A big meet was a dozen

vehicles. In 1976, the BLM informed the racers that there wasn't any money in the 'drag' account. USFRA borrowed 2 trucks from the State and did all the dragging. The only permits required were a \$500.00 bond with the BLM and of course a liability insurance policy. There wasn't any advertising so no one had to worry about tourists. If any showed up they got put to work. A lot has changed since then. But what hasn't changed is the racers desire and need for speed and our hope for a safe race.

# I'D HAVE DONE IT DIFFERENT!

Why didn't you refund 100% of the entry money? It was a good question, the is more answer. complicated. After the expenses of trying to drag a course in three different locations, gas for repeated trips from Salt Lake to Wendover by people desperate to find enough dry salt to stage a race, we simply didn't have enough money in the checking account to return 100%.

Well, the questioner goes on, "I'd have done it different"! I'd have refunded 100% and then asked the general membership to kick in.

Well, maybe we would have ended up with more money back and maybe with more good will in our Karma bank. As it stands, after expenses were covered, all we kept was enough Pre-entry money to squeak into next year. Is it worth mentioning that the USFRA now has less money in the piggy bank than after the end of last racing season? "No Race" isn't just a bummer for the (continued on next page)




